## Program notes

### **Nam Do**

1. *Waltz in a minor by Frederic Chopin*

This is a song I learned a few months ago, and I really like the expressions that Chopin included, like gentle, and dramatic.

2. *No Time To Die by Billie Eilish*

I heard this song on the radio, and I heard the piano accompaniment and decided to give it a try. I'll be playing a slightly modified version from the original, while still keeping its iconic melody

### **Alexa Frcek**

1. *Flames by Robert Vandall*

I have been working on this piece since about June. I really like how exciting and fun this piece is, but the timing of certain parts was definitely challenging.

2. *Sonatina in F Major by Ludwig van Beethoven*

I will be playing part of the first page of this 2 page sonatina. All the different parts of this piece have been hard to learn but I enjoy how lively it is.

3. *The Cadets by J. L. Streabbog*

I have been working on this piece for about the same time as flames, and this piece is probably my most challenging one at the moment. All the fast staccatos and chords have been pretty difficult.

### **Eden Lufkin**

1. *Sonatina in C Major by Muzio Clementi*

This is a fun piece that I have played for three months.

2. *Menuet by J. S. Bach*

3. *Little Piece*

I like the melody and I have played this for about 5 months.

## **Miko Noel**

### 1. *Prelude in c minor by J. S. Bach*

I have been working on this piece for about 8 months, but I took a break in between. I enjoy this piece a lot because of the rhythm and technicality of it.

### 2. *Sonatina in C Major, Op.55 No. 1 and 2 by Friedrich Kuhlau*

I have been working on the first movement for around 8 months with a break between. I started the second movement about 4 months ago. I like the staccatos in these two pieces.

### 3. *The Avalanche by Stephen Heller*

I have been practicing this piece for around 5 months now. I really enjoy the fast paced tempo of this piece, and all the chords.

### 4. *In the Goldfield Saloon by Heather Morris*

I started this piece about 8 months ago. This was my first time playing this type of music, and I very much enjoyed the different rhythm and swing.

## **Sofia Pezo**

### 1. *Invention No. 4 by J. S. Bach*

This is the second invention by Bach I've played. It was a bit challenging at first because of all the sequences and patterns that come back throughout the piece, but once I got the hang of it I started to have more fun with it. I love how Bach blends different phrases into his pieces, and it's been really fun to play.

### 2. *Bagatelle in A-flat Major by Ludwig van Beethoven*

I started working on this piece about a month and a half ago and I learned it pretty quickly. It's a very simple piece, and I'll be performing the first two pages.

### 3. *Nocturne in C-sharp minor*

I've been working on this piece for a couple of months, and it's definitely one of the most challenging I've ever played. I love Chopin's pieces and I love the melody of the nocturne, and I'm really proud of how far it's turned out.

4. *Stormy seas by Caroline Miller*

I first learned this piece two years ago. I was going to submit it for the CM in spring of 2020, but I ended up choosing a different piece instead by the same composer. I really love the emotion of this piece and how it portrays a stormy sea. There's definitely a contrast from when I last played it (about a year and a half ago), and I'm excited to play it again.

## **Ginny Stenstrom**

1. *Tarantella by Moritz Moszkowski*

This is a piece from the late romantic era. The left hand of this piece was difficult due to the fingering on the broken chords, however once I have mastered it I enjoy the piece very much.

2. *Three Fantastic Dances (First movement) by Dmitri Shostakovich*

I used this piece in the CM last year. I have not played many contemporary pieces so I chose to expand my piano playing abilities with this song.

3. *Valse Etude by William Gillock*

This is one of my favorite pieces I can play. This won me state honors last CM, and I can see why; this song is beautiful without a doubt.

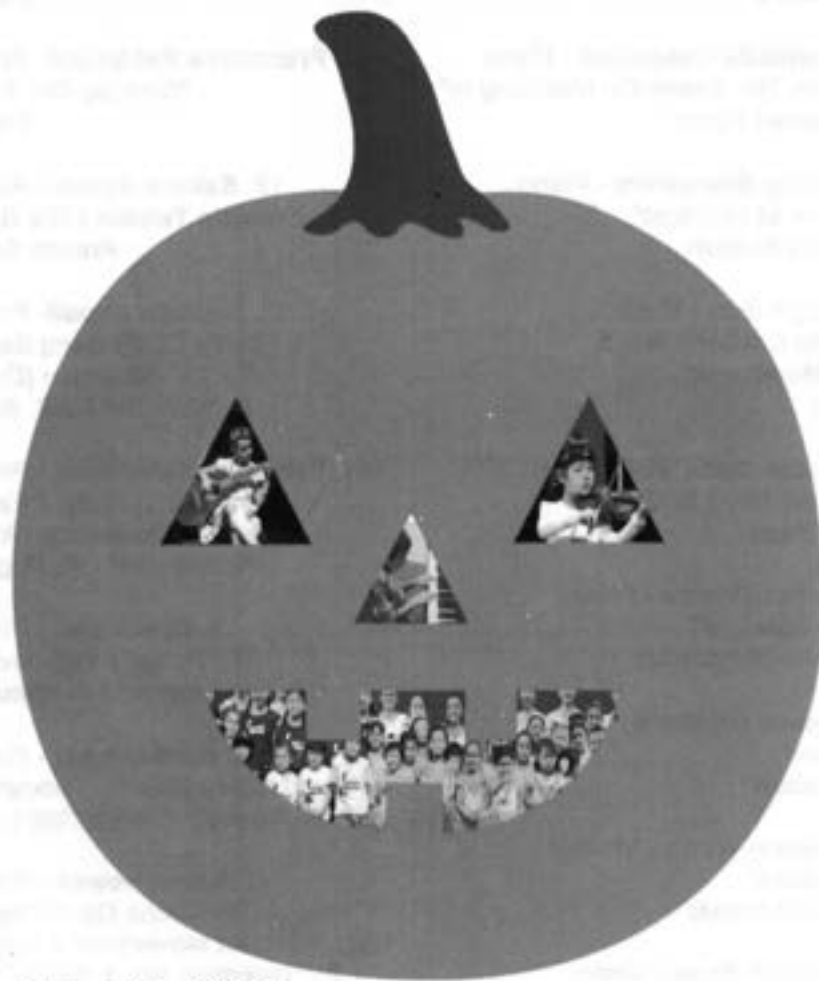
